MEDIA ALERT -- 2009 WONDERFUL WEDNESDAYS AT CAC

Douglasville, Georgia – The Cultural Arts Council of Douglasville/Douglas County is offering its annual Wonderful Wednesday programs for children and young people, 7 to 15 years old, again this year at the Cultural Arts Center on the third, fourth and fifth Wednesdays in July from 2 until 4 p.m. During these hands-on workshops, led by expert and experienced teaching artists, participants will explore the art and ideas on view at the Cultural Arts Center this summer featuring “Mixed Bag,” an exhibit of fine crafts created by West Georgia artisans.

On Wednesday, July 15th, writer and storyteller Lisa Street always offers hands-on educational fun for workshop participants who will write poetry as well as create crafts inspired by the artworks on display and CAC’s butterfly garden. On July 22nd, quilter and textile designer Terumi Todd will help participants make “quilts” from paper strips and squares inspired by the textiles on display including traditional patterns quilted by Marge Frost, Olgarita Lee’s African American – themed pieces, and Todd’s textiles influenced by her Asian heritage. On July 29th, painter and art teacher Tamara Morgan will offer a workshop on stained glass for Wonderful Wednesday Workshop participants who will learn how to create “stained glass” designs with oil pastels and watercolor on rice paper. This is sure to be a beautiful afternoon for everyone!

Workshop fees are \$7 per child (\$5 for CAC family members), which includes all materials and supplies as well as an afternoon snack. To register, call 770-949-2787.
