MEDIA ALERT – 2010 WONDERFUL WEDNESDAYS AT CAC

Douglasville, Georgia – The Cultural Arts Council of Douglasville/Douglas County is offering its annual Wonderful Wednesday programs for children and young people, 7 to 15 years old, again this year at the Cultural Arts Center on the second, third and fourth Wednesdays in July from 2 until 4 p.m. During these hands-on workshops, led by expert and experienced teaching artists, participants will explore the art and ideas on view at the Cultural Arts Center this summer exhibition *The Flower Show*.

On July 14th, crafter, painter, photographer and gourd decorator, Jane Ballou, offers collage techniques for participants who will learn how to create beautiful flower-themed cards and bookmarks using different styles of paper and water-based translucent glazes. On July 21st, local artist and jewelry designer, LeeAnn Messerschmidt, will help participants create floral motif mixed-media jewelry after observing the colors and patterns found throughout the exhibit. On July 28th, author and poet, Alice Shapiro, offers hands-on educational fun for workshop participants who will study and discuss the summer exhibition and write poetry-based-dramas as inspired by the artwork.

Workshop fees are \$7 per child (\$5 for CAC family members), which includes all materials and supplies. To register, call 770-949-2787.
